1 Samuel 8:1-7

Israel Demands a King

- —Cause for change Samuel's sons 1-3
 - -God's standards ignored Deut 16:18-20
- Long lasting effects Impact of a king
 - -God evaluates their request vs 7-8
- —God allows the change Israel had a choice
 - God does reveal the coming consequences

The Desire to be like others

- —Israel was afraid to be distinctive
 - -They stood out Deut 4:32-40 Lev 19:2
- They were rejecting God as their ruler
 - -We cannot follow both James 4:4
- —Instead of looking to God we compromise
 - -Do what everyone is doing Deut 17:14-20

Consequences of their Choice

- —What will your future king do? 11-13
 - -He will take 11, 13, 14, 16
 - -Your sons, daughters, property, crops, livestock
 - -You will become his slaves
 - You will regret it some day
- —Israel does not learn 19-22
 - —Give them what they want

The good news

- —The Lord will not cast away His people
 - -Samuel's last words 12:17-22
 - -Saul proves to be a failure
 - God provides godly David
 - -God sends His own Son Rom 1:3-4
 - -Prophet, priest, king Heb 4:15-16
